# HAND RANKINGS (HIGHEST TO LOWEST)

Royal Flush - A, K, Q, J, 10, all the same suit.

Straight Flush - Five consecutive cards, all in the same suit.

Four of a Kind - Four cards of the same rank.

Full House - Three of a kind with a pair.

Flush - Any five cards of the same suit, not in sequence.

Straight - Five consecutive cards of different suits.

Three of a Kind - Three cards of the same rank.

Two Pair - Two different pairs.

One Pair - Two cards of the same rank.

High Card - When you haven't made any of the hands above, the highest card plays.

#### **BASIC POKER RULES**

**The Objective:** Win the pot by having the best hand or by having all other players fold before the showdown.

The Setup: Each player is dealt two private cards (Texas Hold'em) with community cards dealt in stages after betting rounds.

**Betting Rounds:** Pre-flop  $\rightarrow$  Flop  $\rightarrow$  Turn  $\rightarrow$  River

Betting Options: Fold, Check, Bet, Call, Raise

## **GAME STAGES**

Pre-Flop: Betting starts after players are dealt their two private cards.

Flop: The first three community cards are dealt.

Turn: A fourth community card is dealt.

River: The final community card is dealt.

Showdown: If two or more players remain, the player with the best hand wins the pot.

## POKER ETIQUETTE

Respect the dealer and other players.
Keep up with the action.
Protect your hand and your chips.
Be mindful of your table talk.
Act in turn.
